The current by law can be found under Article 3: Duties of Officers Section 3.04
The Tyler shall perform such services appertaining to his office as the Lodge may require. For his services he shall receive \$30.00 per meeting.

The Tyler shall perform such services appertaining to his office as the Lodge may require. For his services he shall receive **\$100.00** per meeting.

The Second change I propose is increasing lodge dues from \$80 per year to \$100

Dues

Section 6.01 The dues of each member shall be \$70.00 per annum. At the discretion of the

Lodge, this Lodge’s dues may be automatically and immediately increased or decreased in an amount equal to any increase or decrease in Grand Lodge dues.* Any adjustments made pursuant to the foregoing may be affected by the Lodge for the year in which the adjustment in Grand Lodge dues is effective, even if dues notices for such year were previously sent to the members.

* If the Lodge decides to increase its dues, in addition to the Grand Lodge action on dues or assessments, the Lodge must follow the usual procedure for the amendment of the By-Laws.
